

2013 Highlights

A record \$276,286 in cash assistance was provided for charitable purposes in Estonia in 2013.

A scholarship at the Tartu University Foundation founded by Ilo Leppik, M.D. in memory of his father, former Tartu University professor Elmar Leppik, received an infusion of \$90,000. Candidates are selected by competition run by a committee of several faculty members. The Elmerice and AndreasTraks scholarship fund distributed \$33,893 to thirteen Tartu University students.

The Oleg and Maie Golubjatnikov memorial scholarship \$3760 was awarded to two masters candidates in medical technology and biomedical physics. This scholarship was set up by the Fund to honor the Golubjatnikovs for their contribution as board members to healthcare in Estonia. A medical student received the Harald Luning memorial stipend. Among other educational grants were \$23,000 to Krabi School and \$5000 to Noarootsi Gümnaasium.

Youth-serving organization received \$59,200. Among them were the Tartu Christian Adolescents' Home (\$30,000), Bethel pastoral Care in Tallinn, Kohila Childrens' Center, Eidapere Pupils' Home, Girl Guides and Boy Scouts.

Donations in memory of Maya Paabo went to the Estonian Cancer Center.

The Fund's support is channeled in cooperation with reliable charitable organizations and educational institutions in Estonia.

The Fund seeks to maximize support by supplementing income from contributions with income from investing bequests.
